



Indoor American Shoot 29th January 2012

With such a good response to this tournament last year and the excellent food and location at Wix, we have booked it again, so don't miss out, get your entry in early.

The last Sunday in January (29th in 2012) was chosen because generally we seem to have turned the corner and archers are starting to look forward to the outdoor season. The chance to shoot outdoor distances in January with no wind, rain or snow, (as we had this year!!) has got to be good.

2.5 dozen arrows at each distance of 60, 50 and 40yds, 7.5 dozen in total. Garmin say that Wix Equestrian Centre is 41 miles and 32 minutes (mostly dual carriageway) from Perris Archery at Rettenden, who are sponsoring the event.

Please try and save your sight marks from this year as we would like to minimise archers using this venue to "find" new ones, it really is not ideal. We have to try to avoid any damage to the centre walls and of course your arrows.

Wix Equestrian Centre has a floor of shavings and rubber chippings, and as you might expect there may be extras..... The lighting is OK but there is no heating so, dress for warmth and comfort as no dress regulations will apply.

Wix Equestrian Centre runs a very good café from 8.30am, here you can get hot and cold food and drinks. An all-day breakfast for instance is less than £4, ham egg and chips £3.65, scampi, jacket potatoes and much more are on the menu - make a day of it, you may want something warm.
